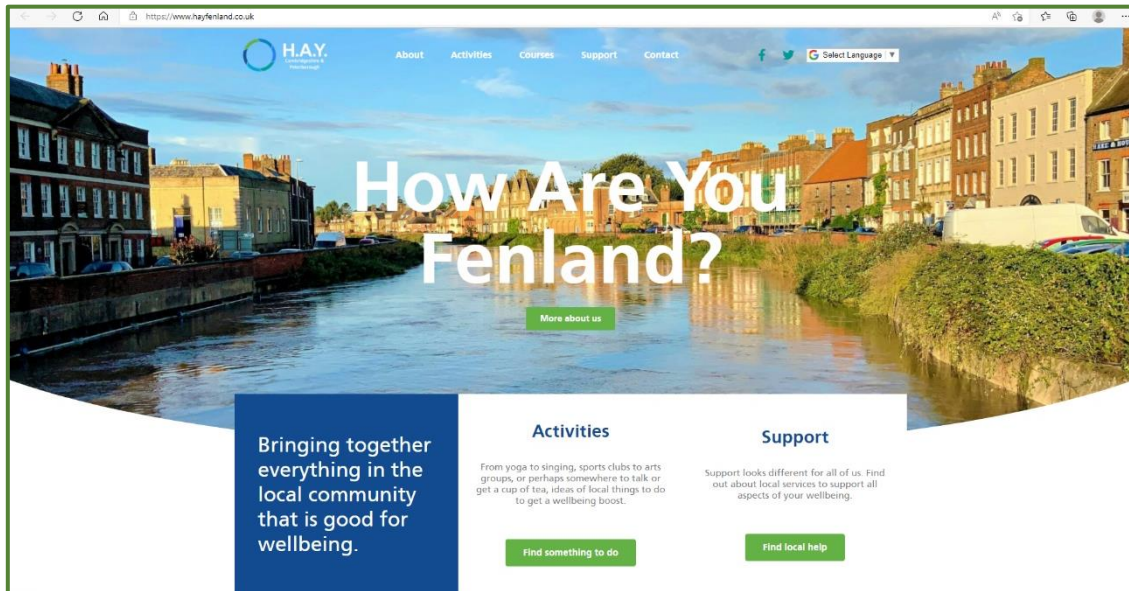


Lewis has exited the project and is now attending FACET 2 days a week building on his practical woodwork skills.

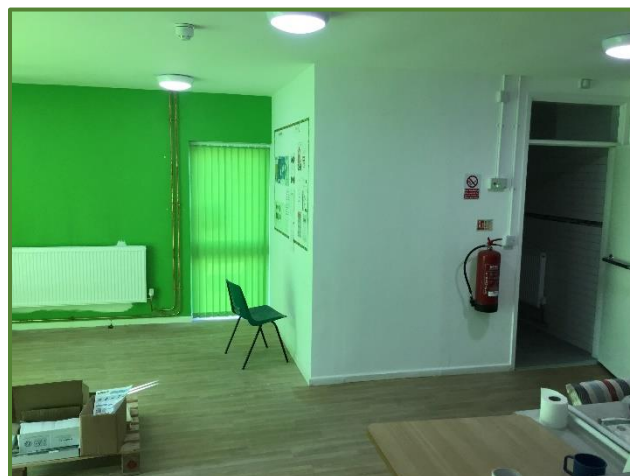
Bradley has joined the project and is looking to build on his independent living skills.
