We are continuing to support 2 participants on a face-to-face basis as it is deemed to be in their best interest to attend.

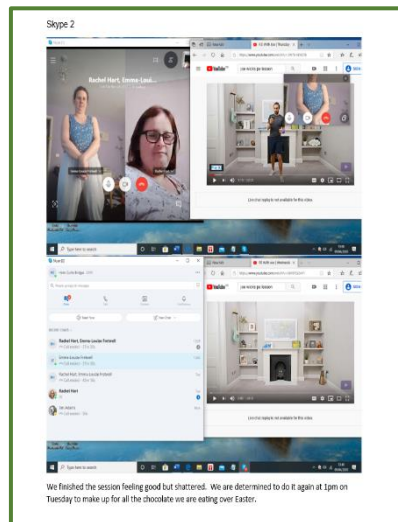
We are also continuing to support all our other participants remotely, again we are using WhatsApp video, phone and emails to provide ongoing work and support.
