



## Building Better Opportunities Progress report Oct-Dec 20

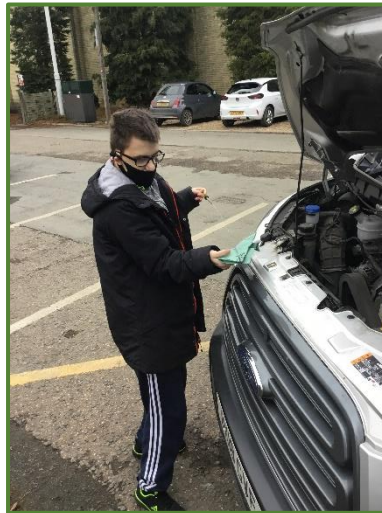
This report has been produced by participants of the BBO project



We have 2 new participants join the project, they are Charmaine and Beverley.

We have continued to support our participants in work related activities.

These have included land-based maintenance in weeding, tiding, pruning and leaf clearing as well as window cleaning around FACET.



We are continuing to provide remote support to our participants who are unable to or do not feel comfortable to return.

This is being provided through What's app, Facebook, phone and email.



Nathan has also joined the project. We are providing remote support for him as he does other activities during the week.

Jayce has also joined the project and is interested in building on his literacy and numeracy skills along with work related activities.



We are continuing to promote our ethical values through upcycling, recycling and gardening.

John has been working on upcycling old chairs by re-staining them and cutting material for the seats and backs so they can be brought back into use.

Beverley has been using plastic bottles and other recycled materials to make a wind chime.

Christian also used recycled materials to make a wind chime, these will go into the sensory garden.

Bob has also been cutting logs to size and drilling holes to make a large insect habitat also for the sensory garden.



4 participants are working towards an Entry level 2/3 qualification in Enterprise. Emma has just completed her Entry level 3 qualification.

We are also supporting participants in gaining skills around independent living and employability.



Jayce has been supported to apply for and attain a bus pass, this will support him to attend the project and receive further travel training from his home support.

Maggie has also joined the project and has completed her person-centred plan and is interested in building on IT and art /design skills.



Many of the participants have taken part in a group Christmas art project. This is to design a Christmas bauble with a snowman design. This has involved participants using measuring, cutting, stencil design, designing and assembling skills.

The bauble will be part of a FACET groups project.



Beverley was asked if she would be able to design a calendar for the project as she wanted to try something she had not done before. She took ownership of the task and used her IT skills to research calendar templates online and to add photos of the group onto it. The project now has a 2021 calendar.
